Getting there (car)	Take motorway exit Richterswil, follow further directions. Around 1,5 km by foot (15'); the marked way must not be left.
Start	09:00 – 10:00. Distance from meeting place: appr. 15 minutes' walk

All competitions are run under the Swiss Olympic doping rules. Anti doping controls may be performed for runners of any category. With registration, the participants accept the rules of Swiss Olympic. In the classes HE/DE, only those athletes having acknowledged the Swiss Olympic Association's anti-doping rules will be allowed to compete. If not done already, before their start athletes will have to sign the anti-doping agreement of the Swiss Olympic Association at the meeting place.

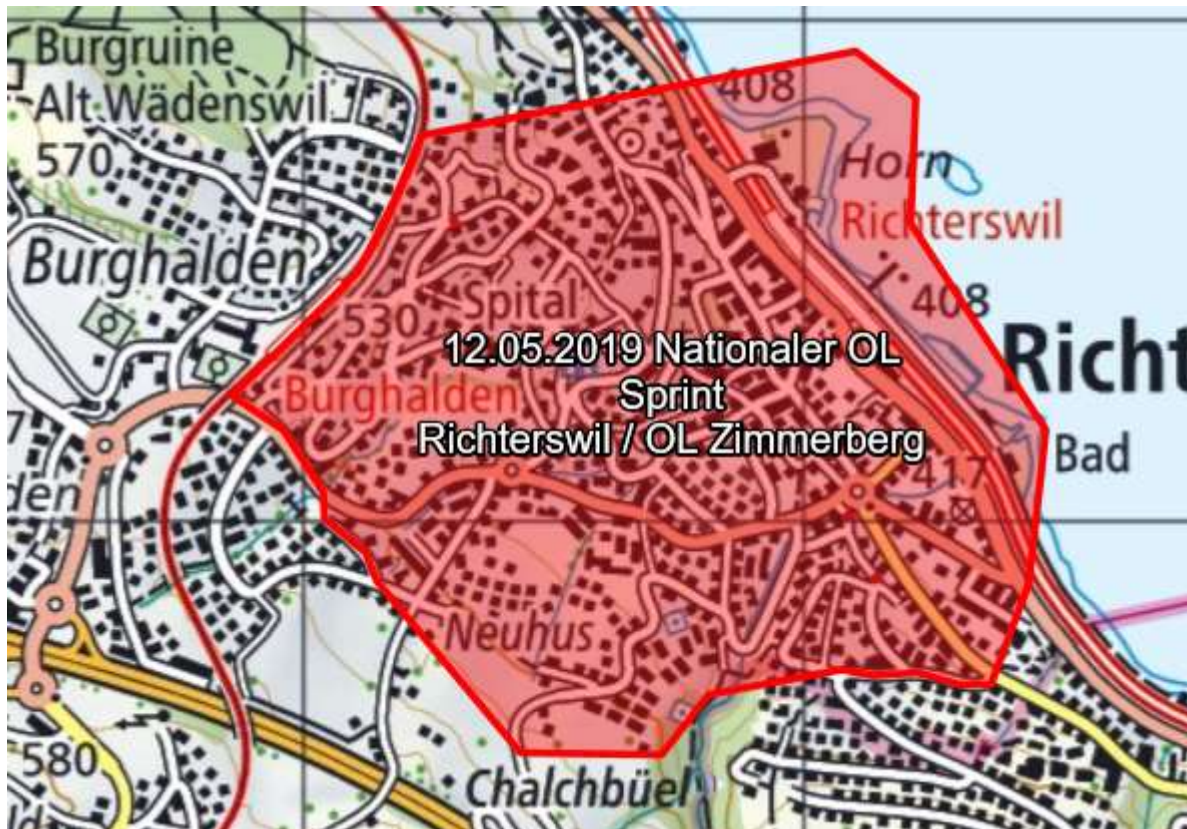

There will be a quarantine set up for the participants of the test race for the classes HE/DE, H20/D20, H18/D18, H16/D16 close to the meeting place. The meeting place must not be entered before having finished the race. Further details will follow with the instructions.
